

Jalen Hurts and DeVonta Smith Steal Nashville's Final Moment

STORY

Read the story, then answer the questions.

How the Game Began

On Sunday, September 20, 2026, the Philadelphia Eagles, the away team, beat the Tennessee Titans, the home team, 24-20 in Nashville. Philadelphia moved to 2-0, while Tennessee fell to 0-2. Tennessee struck first when Hooker intercepted Hurts at the goal line and returned the ball 92 yards. Ward then sneaked in from 1 yard out. With Barkley briefly out, Bigsby, Shipley, and Hurts moved Philadelphia downfield. Bigsby's 2-yard touchdown tied the game early in the second quarter.

The Deciding Moments

Smith's 22-yard touchdown put Philadelphia ahead 14-7. Before halftime, Ward found Ayomanor and Spears, setting up Slye's field goal, but Philadelphia led 14-10. Elliott's 58-yard field goal stretched the lead. Ward then hit Ridley for 25 yards and ran in from 1 yard, tying the game 17-17. Harris intercepted Hurts, giving Tennessee a huge chance. Ayomanor and Spears made big gains, and Slye put Tennessee ahead 20-17 with 1:56 left. Hurts answered as Smith's 19-yard catch set up Cooper's winning 3-yard touchdown with nine seconds left.

Big Performances and Takeaways

Smith led Philadelphia with 10 catches for 117 yards and a touchdown. His reliable hands gave Hurts a trusted target after two interceptions. Hurts passed for 264 yards and two touchdowns, while Wicks had 74 receiving yards. Ward showed promise for Tennessee by passing for 183 yards, running for two touchdowns, and avoiding an interception. Pollard ran for 64 yards as the Titans gained 122 rushing yards. Philadelphia now heads to face the Chicago Bears, while Tennessee prepares for the New York Giants after a close loss that showed it can compete.

intercepted (v.): Caught a pass thrown by the other team, taking the ball away.

stretched (v.): Made something larger or increased it.

reliable (adj.): Able to be trusted to do a good job consistently.

compete (v.): To play strongly against another team or person.

- 1 **D** Bigsby scored a 2-yard touchdown to tie the game.

After Tennessee took the first lead, Philadelphia moved downfield and Bigsby scored a 2-yard touchdown. The article says this touchdown tied the game early in the second quarter.

- 2 **C** Tennessee scored before Philadelphia did.

The section explains that Tennessee scored after Hooker intercepted Hurts and Ward ran in a touchdown. This shows that Tennessee was the first team to score.

- 3 **B** Cooper caught a 3-yard touchdown pass.

With nine seconds left, Cooper scored on a 3-yard touchdown after Smith's 19-yard catch helped set up the play. That touchdown gave Philadelphia the winning lead.

- 4 **A** Both teams traded leads, but Philadelphia made the final scoring play.

The section describes several lead changes, including Tennessee's 20-17 lead late in the game. Philadelphia then answered with Cooper's winning touchdown in the final seconds.

- 5 **B** Smith was a receiver Hurts could depend on to make catches.

The section says Smith's reliable hands gave Hurts a trusted target after two interceptions. This means Hurts could rely on Smith as a receiver.

- 6 What a good answer includes:

A strong answer should explain that both teams had notable performances, with Philadelphia receiving key contributions from Smith and Hurts and Tennessee showing it could compete through Ward and its rushing offense. It should support the central idea with at least two accurate details, such as Smith's 10 catches for 117 yards and a touchdown, Hurts's 264 passing yards and two touchdowns, or Ward's 183 passing yards and two rushing touchdowns.
