STORY

Read the story, then answer the questions.

How the Game Went

Detroit opened with a 7-0 lead when Jahmyr Gibbs finished a drive featuring runs of 21 and 11 yards. After halftime, Derrick Barnes intercepted Tyler Shough, and Gibbs scored again before Jared Goff hit Amon-Ra St. Brown for a 19-yard touchdown and a 21-0 lead. New Orleans rallied behind scores by Kendre Miller, Devaughn Vele, and Juwan Johnson, tying the game with 1:07 left. A late Saints field-goal try missed, and St. Brown's 4-yard overtime catch gave Detroit a 31-30 win.

Standout Performers

Gibbs powered Detroit's attack with 156 rushing yards and two touchdowns, repeatedly finding gaps in New Orleans's defense. St. Brown was Goff's reliable target, catching 10 passes for 67 yards and two touchdowns, including the winner. For the Saints, Shough showed poise during the comeback, throwing for 410 yards and three touchdowns. Chris Olave was especially dangerous downfield, recording 10 catches for 182 yards. Jameson Williams also made a key 22-yard overtime catch that moved Detroit to the 5-yard line.

What It Means

The victory puts Detroit at 1-0 before a trip to face the Buffalo Bills, giving the Lions proof that their offense can finish close games. After last season's 9-8 record, Detroit wanted Week 1 to show its playoff hopes remain alive. New Orleans falls to 0-1 before meeting the Baltimore Ravens, yet its comeback offered an encouraging sign. The Saints kept competing after trailing 21-0, while Detroit answered under pressure. That perseverance showed how teams can depend on every unit late in a game.
